

CEDAL 2022 Timetable

All units are available in any teaching period as an online unit. Separate to this, CEDAL offers workshops on related themes that are free for any of our ACD VET students. In selecting your units for each term, you may like to consider when the workshops are available.

In Term 1, 2022 the theme of the workshops will be Biblical Studies.

12th February: Tools for Biblical Studies

We live in a very different world to that of the first readers of the Bible, and this puts up barriers between our reading and our understanding. In this first workshop we will learn about biblical interpretation and its frameworks. We will develop skills in using systematic approaches to thinking through how the various contexts shape meaning. Finally, we will learn about exegesis, the tool used by all students of the Bible whether they are starting out their journey or a professor, to interrogate the Bible and understand well what it would have meant in its day.

26th March: Luke/Acts in Context

In our second workshop we will explore the life and times of the New Testament world, how society worked, the issues people face, and who some of the major characters were. In the second half of the workshop, we will dive deeply into the book of Luke & Acts. This workshop will be jointly facilitated with Rev Dr John Squires, a Luke/Acts scholar and former Principal of the Perth Theological Hall.

Other Terms
